Articles of incorporation organizing Intergroup of Western North Carolina were approved Sunday, June 20, at a meeting of the Intergroup Council held at the Intergroup office in the Parkway Office Building.

The articles were signed by the incorporators and mailed to Raleigh where the new corporation - non-profit - will be registered with the secretary of state.

The nominating Committee, headed by Smiley M., made its report. Nominated were: Mary C., chairman, Traditional Group, Asheville; Gilmer C., vice chairman, Waynesville Grace group; Joe S., treasurer, Hendersonville group; Adelaide G., secretary, Asheville Serenity group, and Ann S., assistant secretary, Asheville Victoria Road group.

AT the next Council meeting, scheduled for Sunday, July 18, at the Parkway Office Building, new officers will be elected and by-laws for the new corporation will be ratified.

The Council voted to make Pete G. an honorary chairman in recognition of his services to the group.
