The Fall General Service Assembly was held in Winston Salem on November 22 - 23. Approximately 400 DCM's, alternates, GSR's, alternates, and other interested AA's were in attendance. Workshops were on Recovery, Unity, and Service; the theme was Back to Basics. There were 224 eligible voters, who elected Bill S of Taylorsville (District 11) as our delegate, Causey W of Wilson (District 91) alternate delegate, and outgoing delegate James J of Wilson as area chairman. James chose Judy M (DCM) of Cary (District 31) as secretary/treasurer. Ray D, DCM of District 70 was elected Grapevine chairperson.

District 80 GSR's business meeting and work shop was held in Bryson City on Sunday December 14. Items discussed were the problem of self support, lack of group contributions to GSO, host group for January 87 Eating Meeting, and election of DCM and alternate for 1987-88.

Some good input on self support came from the GSR's. They suggested to inform groups prior to meetings of the financial problems AA is having and ask their group at that time for a group conscience vote on contributions. Also a treasurer's report is suggested every month so that all members of a group know their groups financial condition.

Since no group came forward to host the district eating meeting and it was rumored a group not present would host, a decision was put off until this group could be contacted. GSR's and groups will be notified ASAP as to where the meeting will be held. There will be a meeting.

Bob R former alternate DCM was elected DCM. Herb J of Bryson City was elected alternate DCM. No other nominations made.

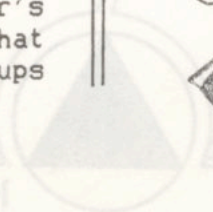

1986 Summary

In the fiscal year 1986, Intergroup received \$6957.35 in group contributions from 38 out of 54 groups; \$1381.99 in individual contributions from 24 different people; and sold \$1267.04 worth of literature. Expenses totaled \$9102.40 During the year, there were 1179 phone calls to the office and answering service and 429 visitors to the office. Sometimes our balance was low, but the groups and individuals always seem to come through when we need them.
