

#### How does a meeting become a group?

An AA group has one or more trusted servants, including a General Service Representative (GSR). The group may decide to have the GSR register the group, usually with the help of the district secretary. There's no requirement for a group to register, but registration has its benefits. Doing so connects the group (and its meetings) to the entire AA service structure!

- Area 51 is notified of the new group
- GSO assigns the new group a six-digit ID number
- GSR receives GSO's New Group Packet
- The group can opt to be listed in GSO's next biannual print directory

#### Is my home group part of AA as a whole?

- Look in the Directory of AA Groups in the Eastern U.S. (at Central Office)
- Contact your district secretary
- Check with the Area 51 secretary
