


An Example of How Groups Might Contribute to the A.A. Service Structure*

Treasurer: From the By-Laws: Has charge and custody of all funds of Central Office; is responsible for the accuracy of all financial records of Central Office; creates receipts and makes disbursements as approved by the Central Office's various committees; arranges for preparation and filing of all required tax returns; prepares an annual financial report and monthly financial report; presents it to the Central Office Board and CORs. At least five years' continuous sobriety at the time of taking office.

2014–2015 Alternate Chair: From the By-Laws: Shall perform the duties of the Chairman when requested by the Chairman or in the case of his absence or inability to act; shall perform other duties as occasionally assigned; shall have at least five years' continuous sobriety at the time of taking office.

2014–2015 Chair: From the By-Laws: Shall preside at Central Office Board and COR Committee meetings; shall see that all decisions of the Committees are acted upon.; pursuant to specific authority given on occasion by the Committees may sign, and deliver contracts and other documents in the name of North Carolina Mountain Central Office Inc.; with the recommendation and approval of the Central Office Board, shall call for eligible people to stand for positions and appoint chairpersons of standing and special subcommittees; shall break tie votes of the Central Office Representatives and Central Office Board votes; shall perform all duties incident to the office of Chairman and other duties that may occasionally be assigned by the Committees.; shall have five years' continuous sobriety at the time of taking office.

From AA.org: FAQ About A.A. Web Sites

Q. What A.A. information is suitable for a web site?

A. [T]he group conscience will determine the contents. Copyright restrictions apply to material displayed on the web site - just as copyrights protect A.A. literature. Permission must be obtained from G.S.O. prior to including A.A.W.S. material on your web site. However, web sites created by A.A. areas, districts and central/intergroup offices are permitted to quote a phrase, sentence or brief paragraph excerpted from A.A. literature—such as the Big Book (Alcoholics Anonymous), Twelve Steps and Twelve Traditions, The A.A. Service Manual, and Conference-approved pamphlets-without a prior, written request to do so. When this occurs, the proper credit line should be included to ensure that the copyrights of A.A. literature are protected. After a quotation from a book or pamphlet, the credit line should read: "Reprinted from (name of publication, page number), with permission of A.A. World Services, Inc."

The A.A. Preamble is copyrighted by the A.A. Grapevine. Beneath it, and beneath any article or cartoon reprinted from the Grapevine, these words should appear: "From the (date) Grapevine. Reprinted with permission of The A.A. Grapevine, Inc." If you wish to include items on your web site that are currently available on the G.S.O. or Grapevine web site, we suggest that you link to the appropriate pages of those sites. Again, aside from web sites created by A.A. areas, districts and intergroups/central offices, all others wishing to include A.A. material on their web sites must request permission from G.S.O. to do so.
