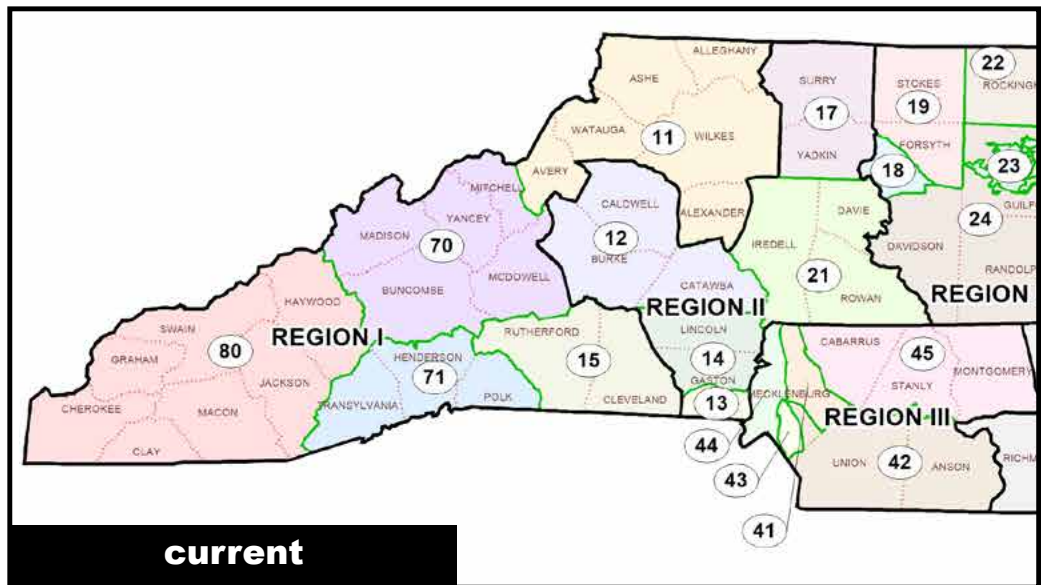
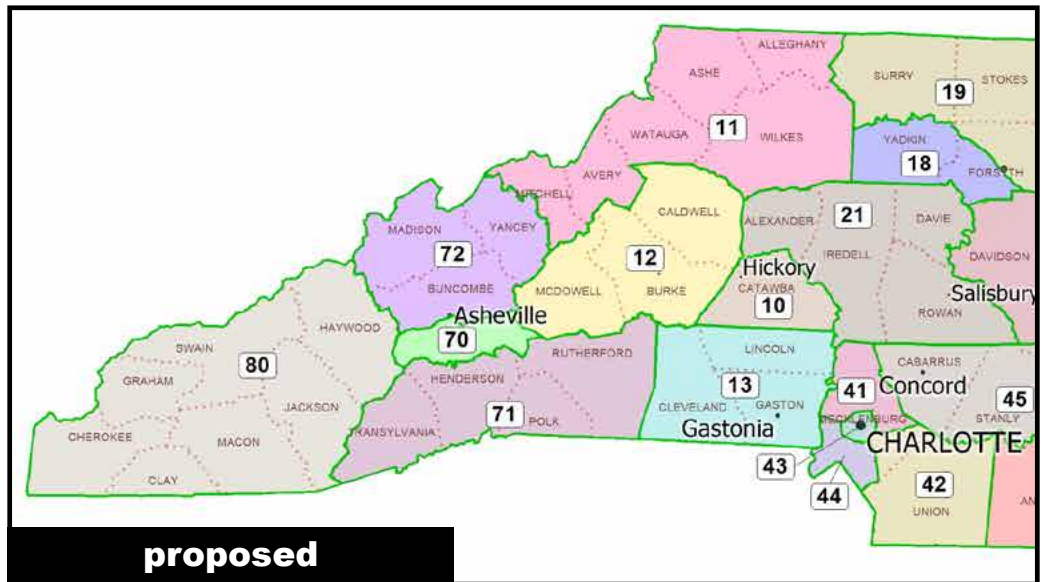
Will the Area 51 Plans for Redistricting Affect your Group?

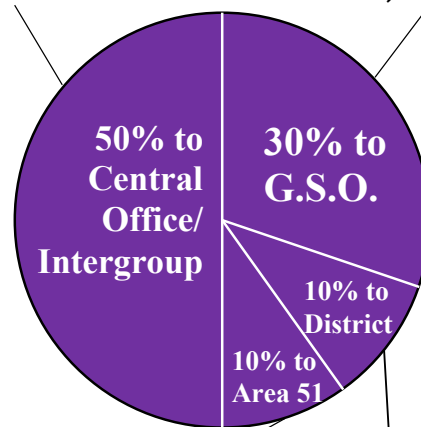

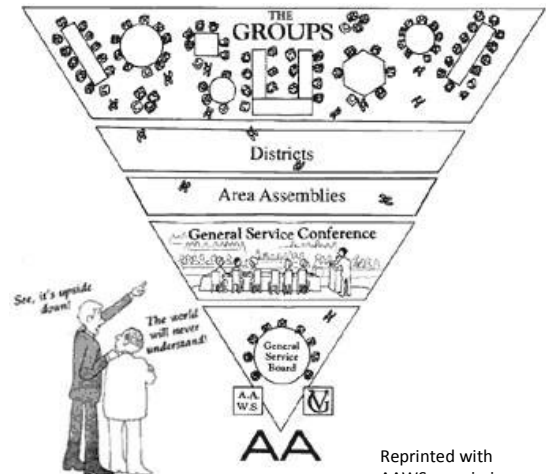
