Another Saturday Night

I spoke at a treatment center last night. I've been going there for about 14 months. I love speaking and look forward to it every month. I made the people laugh last night, though I didn't intend to.



I've asked other AA members to accompany me to this meeting. One said no with, "It's my sister's birthday Saturday night." Another made the excuse, "This is Tuesday and Saturday is a long ways off." And then I've just had no-shows. But I show up.

Before these meetings start, I usually ask my buddy, God, "You put the words in my mouth." I sometimes share my story about my life growing up in alcoholic homes. I tell them about how I married my drinking partner. I explain how I went to AA to find help for him, but when I got there the people at the podium were telling my story.

I tell them how my home group got me involved in service work. And they asked me to chair a Sixth-Step meeting. I also tell them that I now understand the First Step because I had to take it three times (in and out of AA and back again) and that I understand the Fourth Step because I need a paper and pencil. I love paper and pencil, ever since I learned to write to my dad when I was very young.

I share with them about my disgust with God after a religious friend took her own life. I especially tell them how I felt about God when I

first walked in the doors of AA. I tell them about how it was hard for me to hear that I needed to embrace some kind of Higher Power so I'd have something to give my fears to and be able to sleep at night.

So, when I closed the meeting last night by reading from the Big Book, I prefaced it with, "This is about God..." and they all laughed. I like to close the meetings at the treatment center with the Serenity Prayer so people of all religions and people of no religious affiliation feel included.

Last night, the people on each side of me, and in most of the room, joined arms at the shoulders, like they do at another Twelve Step meeting, and that was OK with me.

As the people were leaving the room, a young man asked which group I attended. I heard him tell a woman, "I want to go where she goes."




